Airport Details:

Reagan Washington Airport (DCA) and Dulles are the regional airports. Dulles is furthest away from the city—about an hour or so with potentially larger traffic delays. DCA is accessible by metro and usually the most expensive.

DCA/Reagan is probably the best option coming from the South, East Coast and Midwest. The train is also an option for anyone coming from New York.

For persons coming from Europe or the West Coast, the only one good option is Dulles International Airport.

Taxis estimates are ca. \$30 to DCA/Reagan and ca. \$60 to Dulles plus traffic delays.

Remember to fly into Richmond and depart from Washington (DC), if you are visiting Hillwood.
